Deep Creek Bridge maintenance works (Gooroolba - Biggenden Road)

Works overview

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will be undertaking maintenance works on Deep Creek Bridge on Gooroolba-Biggenden Road, in early 2025.

Works include replacing the inner timber girders to keep the bridge safe and operational.

Works will commence from **28 January 2025** and take around two weeks to complete, weather and other conditions permitting.

The bridge is a narrow, single lane structure and to facilitate works in a safe and efficient manner, it will remain closed to all traffic daily from **6am-6pm Monday to Friday** until the works are completed.

Electronic signage will be in place along the road prior to works commencing to notify road users of specific dates and times.
